CHRISTIAN LIBERTY MISUSED

Chapter 10

Summary: Paul discusses various misuses of Christian liberty.

I. Liberty misused by Israel (1-13). (A) the blessings of all [1-4], (B) the chastising of most [5], (C) the sins of some [6-10], and (D) the application for all [11-13].

II. Liberty misused by idolatry (14-22). (A) fellowship with Christ [14-16], (B) fellowship with each other [17], (C) fellowship with Jehovah [18], and (D) fellowship with demons [19-22].

III. Liberty misused by conscience (23-33). (A) guidelines for liberty [23-24], (B) illustrations of liberty [25-30], and (C) commands concerning liberty [31-33].

Lesson: *Christian liberty is a great gift from God; we must not misuse it.*
