1 THESSALONIANS

Summary Of 1 Thessalonians: This is one of Paul's earliest letters, written from Corinth around 52 A.D. In it he gives 1) encouragement for Christian perseverance amidst persecution, 2) exhortation for proper Christian conduct, and 3) instruction about the Lord's return.

Lesson: God's word is our complete guide for proper Christian conduct.

Summary: Christian conduct is seen in salvation, receptivity, and fruit.

- I. Their salvation (1-4)
- II. Their receptivity (5-6)
- III. Their fruit (7-10)

Chapter 2:1-12 Paul's Christian Conduct

Summary: Christian conduct is seen in boldness, love, and diligence.

- I. His boldness (1-4)
- **II. His love (5-8)**
- III. His diligence (9-12)

Lesson: Christian conduct depends on salvation, receptivity, and fruit.
