Chapter 2

Summary: Paul describes the Christian life as one of love, forgiveness, and triumph.

- (I) A life of love (1-4): (A) considerate of others [1-2]; (B) joyful over others [3]; and (C) involved with others [4].
- (II) A life of forgiveness (5-11): (A) timely in nature [5-7]; (B) demonstrative in nature [8-9]; and (C) inclusive in nature [10-11].
- (III) A life of triumph (12-17): (A) problematical at times [12-13]; (B) successful at all times [14-16a]; and (C) dependent at all times [16b-17]. Lesson: As Christians we live lives of love, forgiveness, and triumph.
