PAUL'S FIRST MISSIONARY JOURNEY ENDS

Chapter 14

Summary: The first missionary journey continues as Barnabus and Paul enter Iconium. Many Jews and Gentiles believe. But great opposition arises, forcing them to go to Lystra (1-7). A lame man is healed, causing near worship of the apostles (8-18). But Jewish opposition causes Paul to be stoned (19-20). They proceed to Derbe, preach the gospel, and then return to Lystra, Iconium, and Antioch, strengthening the believers. They return home to Antioch and report how God is saving the Gentiles (21-28).

Lesson: *Thank God He "opened the door of faith to the Gentiles".*
