FAITHFUL MINISTRY

Chapter 20

Summary: After the riot in Ephesus, Paul stops at Troas [see 2 Cor. 2:12-13; 7:5-7], then sails to Macedonia. There he writes <u>2 Corinthians</u> (1-2). He visits Corinth and writes <u>Romans</u> (3). He revisits Macedonia and arrives at Troas (4-6). Paul ministers the word and healing, raising Eutychus from the dead (7-12). He then addresses the Ephesian elders at Miletus (13-16). He talks of his past ministry in Ephesus (17-21), his present situation (22-27), and their future responsibilities (28-35). With deep love and emotion, these gentile leaders bid Paul farewell (36-38). Lesson: *Like Paul we must be faithful in our ministries for Jesus*.
