## ACTS 22

## PAUL'S TESTIMONY

## Chapter 22

Summary: Paul gives the Jerusalem mob his testimony. He tells of his Jewish background and opposition to the Way (1-5). He describes his encounter with Jesus, resulting in blindness and conversion (6-11). He explains his healing, his calling, and his baptism (12-15). He relates Jesus' calling of ministry to the Gentiles (16-21). The word "Gentiles" raises a hostile reaction. So the soldiers remove and bind him, and are about to examine him by scourging when he pleads Roman citizenship (22-29). He is then brought before the Sanhedrin for examination (30).

Lesson: All testimonies for Jesus are similar and unique, and wonderful.
