STEPHEN'S ADDRESS

Chapter 7

Summary: Stephen is on trial for blasphemy. He recites Israel's spiritual history, showing her deliverers being rejected the first time, but accepted the second. He reviews God's covenant with Abraham (1-8). He then states Israel's rejection of Joseph (9-16), of Moses (17-50), of the Holy Spirit (51), and of His prophets (52-53). In anger they stone Stephen to death, thereby rejecting him, Jesus Christ, and their own salvation (54-60). **Lesson**: *Do I reject Jesus? May I accept you, Lord, completely in my life*.
