PHILIP'S MINISTRY

Chapter 8

Summary: Saul persecutes the church (1-3)*. Believers scatter and preach** the word. In Samaria Philip preaches*** Christ, with healings and miracles (4-8). Many believe and are baptized, including Simon, a magician (9-13). Peter and John lay hands on them to receive the Holy Spirit. Simon wants to buy this power, but is firmly rebuked by Peter (14-25). Philip leads an Ethiopian eunuch to Christ and water baptism (26-40). Lesson: *In Jesus minister preaching, healing, water and Spirit baptisms*.
