A DEFENSE OF THE GOSPEL

Chapter 2

Summary: Paul affirms Christ's gospel of grace, not of works.

- **I.** The gospel is approved by the apostles (1-10): (A) Paul communicates the gospel of grace [1-5]; (B) the apostles approve the gospel of grace [6-10].
- II. The Gospel is defended before Peter (11-21): (A) Peter's action denies the gospel of grace [11-13]; (B) Paul's rebuke affirms the gospel of grace [14-21].

Lesson: We must not only communicate, but also live the gospel of grace.
