Chapter 3

Summary: Paul uses 7 arguments to defend justification by faith.

I. Experience: [the Galatians were justified by faith, not law] (1-5).

II. Example: [Abraham was justified by faith, not law] (6-9).

III. Effect: [the Law does not justify; it brings a curse] (10-12).

IV. Work: [Christ's sacrifice redeemed us from the curse] (13-14)

V. Promise: [Abraham's promise thru faith is permanent] (15-18).

VI. Purpose: [the Law was only temporary, until Christ] (19-25).

VII. Position: [we are sons through justification by faith] (26-29).

Lesson: We are justified not by our works, but by faith in Christ's work.
