The Gospel According To JOHN

Summary Of John: Jesus' disciple, John, wrote this Gospel about 90 A.D, to portray Jesus in His deity, as the Son of God. He intended to record Jesus' ministry, "that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name" (20:31).

Lesson: Believe in the God-Man, Jesus, and receive eternal life.

JOHN 1 JESUS' IDENTITY

Chapter 1

Summary: John reveals 8 aspects of Jesus' identity.

I. *Jesus' deity* (1-13) reveals (A) the Word [1-3] and (B) the Light [4-13].

II. *Jesus' humanity* (14-34) reveals (A) the Man [14-18], (B) the Christ [19-28], and (C) the Lamb of God [29-34].

III. *Jesus' disciples* (35-51) reveal (A) the <u>Christ</u> [35-42], (B) the <u>King of Israel</u> [43-49], and (C) the <u>Son of Man</u> [50-51].

Lesson: We can't comprehend Jesus' full identity, but we can love Him.
