JOHN 17 THE LORD'S PRAYER

Chapter 17

Summary: Jesus prays to the Father in the Garden of Gethsemane. **Lesson**: "*By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another.*" (*Jn. 13:35*)

I. Jesus Prays For Himself (1-5): He prays for His Glory (1-4); and He prays for His Father's glory (5).

II. Jesus Prays For His Disciples (6-19): He prays for their safety (6-16); and He prays for their sanctification (17-19).

III. Jesus Prays For All Believers (20-26): He prays for our unity with each other (20-23); and He prays for our unity with Him (24-26).

Definitions: *Glory*: worshipful praise, honor, and thanksgiving *Sanctify*: 1. to set apart to a sacred purpose or to religious use [consecrate] 2. to free from sin [purify]
