LUKE 18 KINGDOM POWER

Chapter 18

Summary: The believer experiences kingdom power through *prayer*, *commitment*, and *healing*.

- **I.** Jesus teaches about 2 qualities in <u>prayer</u> (1-17): (A.) the widow shows *persistence* (1-8); (B) the tax collector shows *humility* (9-14). Humility is seen in childlike acceptance of the kingdom (15-17).
- II. Jesus teaches about <u>commitment</u> (18-30): (A) the rich young ruler cannot commit to Christ because of wealth (18-23); (B) the believer commits to Christ, putting Him first, and receiving great blessings (24-30).
- **III.** Jesus teaches about <u>healing</u> (31-43): (A) Jesus provides complete healing through His scourging and death (31-34); (B) Jesus provides physical healing for a blind man (33-37).

Lesson: Kingdom power comes through prayer, commitment, and healing.
