LUKE 20 JESUS' AUTHORITY

Chapter 20

Summary: Jesus' authority is questioned, described, and debated.

I. Jesus' authority is *questioned* by the religious leaders (1-8): (A) His authority is challenged (1-2); and (B) His authority is heavenly (3-8).

II. Jesus' authority is *described* in a parable and an answer (9-26): (A) His authority is divine (9-19); and (B) His authority is supreme [He is the supreme recipient of all, including the tithe {Heb. 7:8}] (20-26).

III. Jesus' authority is *debated* in a question and a scripture (27-47): (A) His authority is mocked (27-40); and (B) His authority is defended (41-47).

Lesson: We must accept Jesus' authority without question or debate.
