LUKE 23 JESUS' DEATH

Chapter 23

Summary: Jesus is tried by Pilate, hangs on the cross, dies, and is buried.

I. Jesus is tried by Pilate (1-25), who (A) affirms His innocence (1-5), (B) sends Him to Herod (6-12), and (C) bargains for His release (13-25).

II. Jesus hangs on the cross (26-43), (A) warning of destruction (26-31), (B) forgiving His enemies (32-38), and (C) saving a criminal (39-43).

III. Jesus dies on the cross (44-56), (A) breathing His last (44-49), and (B) being buried in Joseph's tomb (50-56).

Lesson: Jesus was "delivered up because of our offenses" (Rom. 4:25).
