

# LUKE 7

## HEALING AND FORGIVENESS

### Chapter 7

**Summary:** Jesus ministers salvation in many forms. He heals a centurion's servant (1-10) and raises a widow's son from the dead (11-17). He shows John that He is the Savior by both works and words (18-35). He honors a sinner's faith by forgiving her sins and saving her (36-50).\*

**Lesson:** *Jesus saves our spirit, soul, body, finances, and relationships.*

**I. Jesus Heals A Centurion's Servant (1-10)** as He commends the centurion's faith (1-9) and heals in response to that faith (10).

**II. Jesus Raises A Widow's Son (11-17)** as He has compassion for her (11-13) and delivers her son from death (14-17).

**III. Jesus Addresses John's question (18-35)** as He answers it by healing (18-23), praising John (24-30), and criticizing His generation (31-35).

**IV. Jesus Saves The Sinful Woman (36-50)** as He receives her worship (36-38) and her faith (39-50).

[\*In verse 50 saved can be translated *deliverance, aid, victory, prosperity, health, help, and welfare*. Peace can be translated *security, prosperity, rest, quietness, harmony* (Strong's Exhaustive Concordance).]
