#### LUKE 8 JESUS' POWER

### **Chapter 8**

**Summary**: Jesus demonstrates power in word (1-21), nature (22-25), deliverance (26-39), and healing (40-56). In Mk 16:15-18 He commissions all believers to exercise these powers.

Lesson: Exercise Jesus' power in word, nature, deliverance, and healing.

### I. Jesus Exercises Power In Word (1-21)

A. Jesus Gives The Parable Of The Sower (1-15) *Meaning:* The word is received by the yielded heart. *Illustrations:* 

*Wayside* [hardened, refuse to believe (Mt 23:13-36)]. *Stony* [shallow: want miracles, not message (Jn 6:60-66)]. *Thorny* [preoccupied with riches, not Jesus (Mt 19:16-22)]. *Good* [committed to Christ completely (Mt 19:27)].

B. Jesus Gives The Parable Of The Lamp (16-18)

Meaning: The word is demonstrated to others.

C. Jesus Gives The Definition Of The True Family Of God (19-21) *Meaning:* The word is heard and put into practice.

### II. Jesus Exercises Power In Nature (22-25)

A. Jesus Calms The Storm (22-24) Lesson: As the Lord leads take control.

B. Jesus Questions The Disciples' Faith (25) Lesson: We may know God's word, but do we believe it?

# III. Jesus Exercises Power In Deliverance (26-40)

A. Jesus Casts Out Many Demons (26-37)

B. Jesus Exhorts The Man To Testify (38-40) Lesson: Believers have power to cast out demons (Mk 16:17).

# IV. Jesus Exercises Power In Healing (41-56)

A. Jesus Overcomes Disease (41-48)

B. Jesus Overcomes Death (49-56)

Lesson: Believers have power over sickness (Mk 16:18), even death (Mt 10:8)
