MARK 11 ACCEPTANCE AND REJECTION

Chapter 11

Summary: Jesus is accepted by the multitude and rejected by the nation.

- **I.** Jesus Is Accepted By The Multitude (1-11) as He makes His triumphal entry (1-8) and receives the crowd's praise (9-11).
- II. Jesus Is Rejected By The Nation (12-19) as He shows judgment through the fig tree (12-14) and the temple cleansing (15-19).
- III. Jesus Teaches About Faith (20-26) as He shows faith through the fig tree (20-24) and through the importance of forgiveness (25-26).
- IV. Jesus Is Rejected By The Leaders (27-33) as they dishonestly question Jesus' authority (27-28), and He refuses to answer them (29-33).

Lesson: Accepting Jesus brings salvation; rejecting Him brings judgment.
