## THE KING'S CONFRONTATIONS

## **Chapter 22**

Summary: Jesus is beset by confrontations.

- **I. The Religious Leaders Confront Jesus (1-14).** Jesus illustrates that confrontation in the parable of the wedding feast, which shows their resistance to Him.
- II. The Pharisees and Herodians Confront Jesus (15-22). They challenge Him about paying taxes to Caesar.
- III. The Sadducees Confront Jesus (23-33). They mock Him about the resurrection.
- IV. A lawyer Confronts Jesus (34-40). He questions the Lord about the greatest commandment.
- V. Jesus Confronts the Leaders (41-46). He challenges them with a question about the Christ (41-46).

**Lesson**: Jesus, may I not confront You, but submit to You.
