Summary Of Mark: Mark reveals Jesus as God's *Servant*: Jesus said, "The Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many" (10:45). The dual focus of Jesus' life is *service* and *sacrifice*. As He preaches, teaches, heals, and delivers, He serves others, even to death. Jesus commissions us to continue His work in His power, as servants willing to sacrifice for Him [see Mark 16:15-18].

MARK 1 JESUS' MINISTRY BEGINS

Chapter 1

Summary: Jesus prepares for His ministry through John's ministry, Jesus' baptism, and Satan's temptation. He begins His ministry in Galilee, by preaching, teaching, healing, and delivering.

I. Jesus Prepares For His Ministry through (1-13): John's ministry (1-8); His own baptism (9-11); and Satan's temptation (12-13).

II. Jesus Begins His Ministry by (14-45): preaching the Gospel (14-15); calling disciples (16-20); casting out demons (21-28); healing Peter's mother-in-law (29-31); healing many sick and demon-possessed (32-34); preaching throughout Galilee (35-39); and cleansing a leper (40-45).

Lesson: *Jesus demonstrates the ministries we are to perform in His name.*
