Summary Of Revelation: John wrote this book around 95 A.D. to reveal events before, during, and after Christ's second coming. It has 3 sections (1:19): I. "the things which you have seen" (1), II. "the things which are" (2-3), and III. "the things which will take place after this" (4-22). Section III is divided into 4 subsections:(a) the Tribulation (4-18); (b) the second coming (19); (c) the millenium (20); and (d) the eternal state (21-22).
