

## 2 CHRONICLES 10-16

### CALLING UPON GOD

#### Chapter 10 Rehoboam Suffers Revolt

**Summary:** Faced with revolt, Rehoboam rejects counsel for peace (1-7), in favor of war (8-15), causing Israel's 10 tribes to revolt (16-19).

**Lesson:** *Solomon's idolatry and oppression were bound to cause revolt.*

#### Chapters 11-12 Rehoboam Calls Upon God

**Summary:** Rehoboam is strengthened by fortified cities (11:1-12), godly people (11:13-17), and a large family (11:18-23). When Egypt attacks, he seeks God and is delivered (12:1-12). Abijah succeeds him (12:13-16).

**Lesson:** *Obedience brings blessing; disobedience brings defeat.*

#### Chapter 13 Abijah Calls Upon God

**Summary:** Judah is outnumbered by Israel in battle (1-3). Abijah rebukes Israel's idolatry (4-12), calls upon God, and gains victory (13-22).

**Lesson:** *God says, "Call to Me, and I will answer you". (Jer. 33:3).*

#### Chapter 14 Asa Calls Upon God

**Summary:** Asa seeks God and destroys idolatry (1-8). When Ethiopians attack, he calls upon God, and gains victory (9-15).

**Lesson:** *"No weapon formed against you shall prosper." (Isa 54:17)*

#### Chapter 15-16 Asa Serves (15), Then Backslides (16)

**Summary:** Asa heeds God's call (15:1-7), covenants with Him (15:8-15), removes idols (15:16-18), and has peace (15:19). But then he fails to call upon God, trusting in Syria (16:1-10), and the physicians (16:11-14).

**Lesson:** *Consistent obedience is the hallmark of a strong Christian walk.*
